WARNING! COMBUSTIBLE

Emergency Overview:

Pale-yellow or water-white, oily liquid; pungent odor. Irritating to the skin/respiratory tract. Also causes: drowsiness, confusion, staggering, and unconsciousness. Aspiration into lungs can cause serious damage.

Chronic: dermatitis. Combustible.

Precautionary Measures: Avoid exposure to skin. Wear protective clothing: Goggles, Gloves, Apron.

First Aid Procedures: Inhalation: Remove to fresh air and support breathing as needed. Eyes/Skin: Remove contaminated clothing. Flush eyes with plenty of water. Thoroughly wash skin with soap and water. Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Consult physician.

Fire Procedures: Combustible. Can form explosive mixtures in the air. Use water as fog, dry chemical, or carbon dioxide. Water spray may be ineffective as liquid will float on surface and may re-ignite.

Spill Procedures: Notify safety personnel, isolate and ventilate area, deny entry, stay upwind. Shut off heat and ignition sources. Take up with inert material such as sand or vermiculite. Cleanup personnel should protect against exposure.
